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PTSB GOALS FOR 2020

We are hoping 2020 is the year to be fully integrated into the new electronic certification system! We are actively exploring alternative pathways to licensure, working on microcredentials, more clean-up of our rules, and continuing to be a resource for the districts in Wyoming.

COMPUTER SCIENCE / COMPUTING TECHNOLOGY

PTSB now has 6 recognized state programs for Computer Science Endorsement through the following institutions: University of Wyoming, Western Wyoming Community College, Central Wyoming College, Northern Wyoming Community College District, Northwest College, and Casper College. Due the variety of face-to-face and online program opportunities in the state the PTSB Board has decided to sunset an exception authorization (EA) for "Computing Technology". PTSB is collaboratively working with the Wyoming Department of Education to develop micro-credentials for computer science that could possibly lead to endorsement.

MICRO-CREDENTIALING

Micro-credentialing continues to be researched by PTSB as a possible way to recognize professional development programs by awarding a badge to educator certificates. Micro-credentialing is focused on competency-based learning to acquire skills. The PTSB Board has approved that each approved micro-credential will count as ½ renewal credit. *Please be aware that not all micro-credentials are created equal and we have had several vendors promoting micro-credentials that are **NOT** PTSB approved. If your district is interested in a vendor supported micro-credentials please call us first to ensure we will accept the credits. Please see the attachment approved by the PTSB Board on micro-credentials.

PROFESSIONAL INDUSTRY & CAREER PERMIT (PIC)

As a reminder the PTSB Board recently promulgated rules to modify the PIC permit. This change allows alignment with industry credentialing standards and certification. The three areas that still require a bachelor's degree are Business, Agricutlure, and Family & Consumer Science, all other industry areas need only be in compliance with the industry requirements. We are currently examining other opportunities for CTE instructors to collaborate with industry, including licensing CTE instructors from industry fields, externships, and pathways to a standard license. Please contact our agency for more information.

ALTERNATIVE PATHWAYS

PTSB has three subcommittees that are exploring alternative pathways to licensure in CTE education, Professional/Advanced Degree Candidates, and an Out-of-Field Endorsement route. We are actively working to ensure all districts have the opportunity to fill all positions with qualified candidates. More information on these topics will be coming.



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RECOGNITION OF ONLINE TEACHER PREPARATION PROGRAMS

The PTSB Board approved to recognize five online institution's teacher preparation programs. Please see the attachment of which programs are approved. These programs will be considered "in-state" for graduates applying for a license. Some of these programs can be started at any time, which would allow an individual on an exception authorization with our agency to be teaching in the classroom as long as they are enrolled in a program. This EA is renewable up to three years as long as significant progress in the program can be demonstrated and the program is completed at the end of the three years. This is an opportunity for districts to do more "grow your own". Please contact our agency for more information.

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MICRO-CREDENTIALS

Micro-credentials offer educators an opportunity to demonstrate competency of topic-specific subject matters. The rise in popularity of micro-credentials stems from their focus on supporting educator targeted professional development. Through micro-credentials, educators are able to select specific skills they want to learn based on their students' needs and their own interests. As a result, micro-credentials make professional development more personalized, engaging, and relevant to teachers. The opportunity for educators to broaden their skill set through micro-credentialing provides a unique opportunity for content-specific, educator-driven, professional development.

PTSB'S INTEREST IN MICRO-CREDENTIALS

PTSB's interest in micro-credentials derives from exploring alternative paths toward earning meaningful and recognizable professional development. By developing and implementing micro-credentials, it will allow educators to focus on a specific content area in a micro-credential field and allow PTSB the opportunity to reward that effort with a badge to educator certificates. The content areas offered through micro-credential programs vary, and are not considered to be one-size-fits-all program.

PTSB MICRO-CREDENTIAL REQUIREMENTS, PROCESS, & EXPANSION OPTIONS

- Programs MUST be submitted approved by PTSB for PTSB recognition
- Program Length: The length of time necessary to earn a micro-credential depends largely on the program requirements. Typical micro-credentials take approximately 10-15 hours to complete.
- Program must verify and validate that specific skills/competencies have been achieved by participant
 - This verification must be endorsed by the institution/vendor who submitted the program
 - o Must demonstrate highly meaningful and high-quality professional development
- Any changes to the program must be pre-approved by PTSB
- Once a program has been approved the institution/vendor is required to communicate with PTSB when a participant has completed their program
- PTSB will award the micro-credential to the participant's educator license upon confirmation of completion.
- Micro-credentials will count toward professional development. Completion of a micro-credential program will result in the complete 0.5 credit hours awarded per PTSB Rules Chapter 8.



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PTSB MICRO-CREDENTIAL GLOSSARY

TERM	DEFINITION		
Badge	Digital or physical representation of a micro-credential, stack, or credential to represent learning achievements.		
Credential	The acknowledged completion of a thoughtfully designed series or multiple sets of recognized competencies in a program that an educator earned by demonstration of the defined skills or competencies.		
Competence-Based Professional Learning	Learning activities that result in the participants demonstrating evidence of achievement of specified outcomes.		
Continuing Education Unit (CEU) PTSB Rules Chapter 8	Credit for hours spent participating in professional learning at a ratio of 5 semester hours of university/college credit and/or 75 contact hours.		
Earner	The educator or professional submitting evidence for the microcredential.		
Issuer	The group or organization that has created the PTSB approved micro-credential program and validates the educator's competence in the defined skill or set of skills.		
Micro-credential	Recognition achieved through demonstrating competency of a defined skill or competency, including industry-recognized competencies.		
Stack	One organized set of credentials that an educator earns by demonstrating competency of the described skills or competencies. Also referred to as a cluster, collection, assemblage, or amassment.		
Stackable Credential or Career Pathway	The idea that micro-credentials act as part of a sequence of credentials to build upon an individual's qualifications and help that individual move along a career pathway and/or further education/endorsement.
