Check your Renewal Credits Online!

Since fall 2008 educators certified with the Professional Teaching Standards Board (PTSB) have been able to login to the PTSB site, http://ptsb.state.wy.us/, and check the following:

- 1. Endorsement area(s)
- 2. # of renewal credits
- 3. Highly qualified status
- 4. Renewal requirements

You can check your status 24/7. You can also download a copy of your credentials to provide to employers. You may also – and are **encouraged to update your contact information as needed.**

PLEASE READ THIS

- Beginning in Fall 2008 all educators certified with PTSB were given a unique PTSB ID#. When you login to your PTSB account (accessible via the PTSB website, http://ptsb.state.wy.us/) the 1st screen, after you have logged in, has PTSB ID#. You may use this PTSB ID# or your FULL SSN to sign up for PTSB approved workshops.
 - O Your PTSB ID# is **NOT the last 4 digits of your SSN.**
 - You MUST login to the PTSB website to obtain your PTSB ID #
- Beginning in fall 2008, the facilitator for each workshop enters your renewal credit(s). **PTSB no longer** enters your renewal credits.
- Numerous workshop participants continue to only provide the last 4 digits of their SSN. This makes it impossible for renewal credits to be entered. You must provide your FULL SSN or your PTSB ID # in order for your renewal credits to be entered by the facilitator. This is stated on the participant sign-up sheet.
 - O IMPORTANT: If you attended a workshop during the 2008-2009 school year CHECK YOUR RENEWAL CREDITS on the PTSB website. If you only provided a partial SSN you may not have received credit. If you did not receive credit you need to contact the person facilitating the workshop. Do not contact PTSB, PTSB can neither verify your participation nor enter credit for your participation.
 - o It is important that you check this NOW rather than waiting until you are up for renewal and find that the renewal credits you thought you had are not there because pertinent information was not provided. PTSB will NOT be able to go back and remedy this you need to check your renewal credits and contact the facilitator of the workshop.
